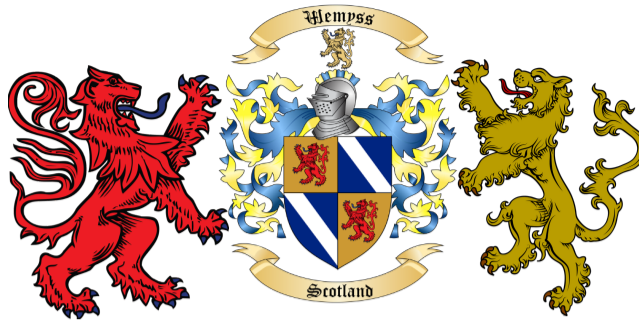

Maxim One: The Kingdom of David, established by God, and upheld by an eternal and continuing mandate does not ask permission, but only proclaims decrees and informs the nations of its peaceful intent to restore the land and its people.

Precept Two

Historical Continuity & Authority

The Covenant of Formation, first declared in three original instruments on the Fifteenth Day of January, Two Thousand and Eleven, established the foundations of governance, crown, and priesthood.

The Proclamation of Sanctuary, Peace, and Prosperity, written on the Fifteenth Day of January, Two Thousand and Twenty–One, extended that covenant to all peoples, pledging peace and sanctuary.

This present World Notice first whispered forth and shaped in the year Two Thousand and Twenty–Two, has been prepared through seasons of refining, advanced and harmonized across instruments, courts, and the Kingdom’s own order, and is now gathered into its final flowering on the Fifth Day of June, Two Thousand and Twenty–Five.

By His Majesty’s Seal, it stands memorialized, synchronized, and certified on this Twenty–Ninth Day of September, in the year Two Thousand and Twenty–Five, and enters the archives of the Internal Kingdom Library (IKL) as a Canon of Record.

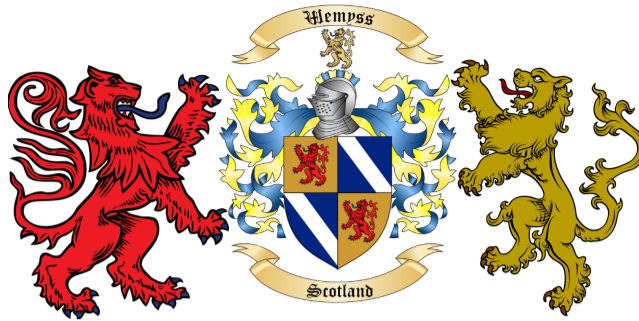
Precept Three

Proclamation of Sovereignty & Jurisdiction

The House and Kingdom of David stand as a Kingdom and Throne of Crown Sovereign Kings, by Royal Authority and Divine Mandate, bearing an Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Mantle; and each King derives his sovereignty from the Everlasting Covenant sworn by the Living God to David. As it was written, so it is

declared: the Throne of David shall not lack a man to sit upon it before the Lord forever. In this age, that Covenant is upheld.

Therefore, neither the courts of men nor the instruments of foreign dominions may presume to possess jurisdiction over His Majesty's Crown, the institutions of the Kingdom, or the Citizens thereof, and that jurisdiction rests alone in Covenant — in Heaven above, and in the Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Combined Courts (EECC) upon the earth.

Only a King is sovereign; and a Sovereign Government is one ordered under a King as its Head. Governments without a King are either chosen republics or democracies; and individuals may be solvent or insolvent, but they are not sovereign.

Exodus 19:6 (ESV): “and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words that you shall speak to the people of Israel.”

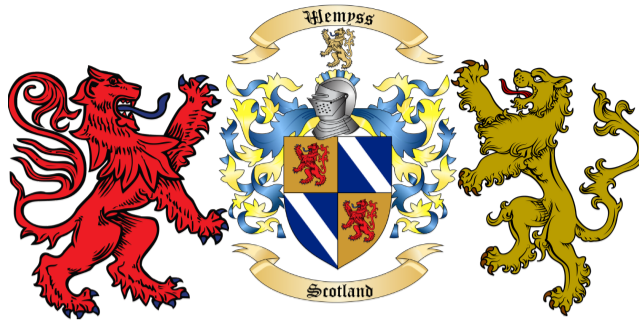

Precept Four

Principles of Governance & Peace

The House and Kingdom of David, by Royal Authority and Divine Mandate, exists not for tyranny, nor for oppression, but for the advancement of Sanctuary, Peace, and Prosperity among all who dwell under its blessing.

Therefore, I, His Majesty King David Joel, Crown Sovereign of the Kingdom, do solemnly declare and publish the guiding principles of our reign and our law:

Act One: Sanctuary

All men, women, and children who come in good faith under the protection of the Kingdom shall find refuge. None shall be cast out who seek peace and righteousness. Innocents shall not be handed to oppression, nor shall the weary be denied rest within our courts and our gates.

Act Two: Peace

The Kingdom of David shall deal justly and faithfully with all nations and peoples. It shall not provoke wars, nor seek unjust conquest, but it shall defend its people, its borders, and its covenant as given from Heaven.

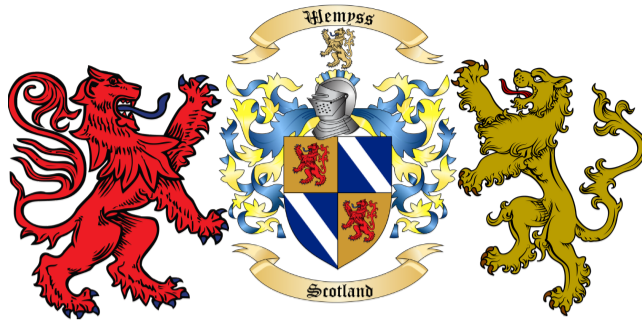
Peace shall be pursued in truth: where equity reigns, peace endures.

Act Three: Prosperity

Prosperity within the Kingdom is not measured only by wealth, but by righteousness, by life, by the strength of families, and the flourishing of God's order in every vocation.

The Kingdom shall guard against oppression, shall uphold just measures and balances in commerce, and shall ensure that prosperity flows not to the few only, but to all who walk uprightly under covenant.

Act Four: Justice in Equity

Justice shall not be one-sided, nor corrupted by bribes. The poor shall not be oppressed, nor the rich favored. Judgment shall be rendered according to equity, wisdom, and sacred law.

All laws and decrees of this Kingdom are subject to the Maxims of Equity and Sacred Writs, which stand as canon in Annex A of this World Notice, and which are binding upon every Royal Officer, Judge, and Citizen thereof.

Act Five: Stewardship of Creation

The Kingdom shall honor the land, the waters, the creatures, and all resources entrusted by God. For the earth is the Lord's, and I govern as stewards, not masters.

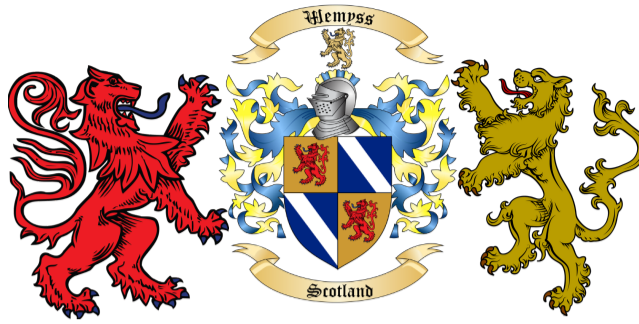
Waste and destruction bring ruin; stewardship and care bring blessing.

Precept Five

Foreign Policy & International Relations

The Kingdom of David is not a cloister unto itself, but an ancient sovereign household, reawakened to bless and deal justly with the families, peoples, and nations of the world.

Therefore, by this World Notice, I extend to all Sovereigns, Governments, and Nations the clear principles of our foreign relations:

Act One: Peaceful Comity Among Nations

The Kingdom enters relations not by conquest or subjugation, but by covenant, friendship, and lawful treaty. I honor the boundaries of other nations as I require ours to be honored.

Act Two: Sanctity of Treaties

Every treaty, alliance, or covenant made with the Kingdom of David shall be grounded in equity, fairness, and mutual prosperity. Treaties shall not be entered in deceit, nor broken lightly, for covenant-breaking brings judgment upon nations.

Act Three: Non-Aggression and Defense of Sovereignty

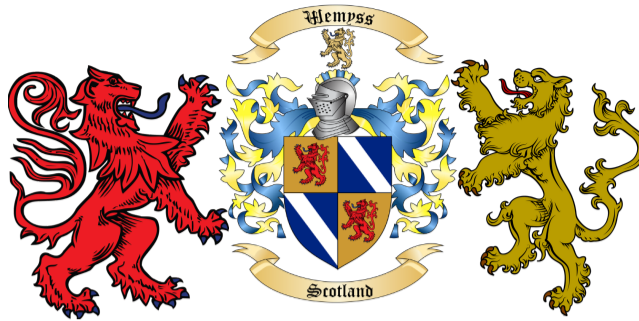

Act Four: Advancement of Righteous Commerce

Commerce is not to be perverted by fraud or oppression but conducted with honest weights and measures. The Kingdom welcomes commerce that leads to mutual

blessing, innovation that uplifts human dignity, and trade that fosters peace, not enslavement.

Act Five: Liberty of Nations in Covenant

All nations are free under God to govern themselves in their lands, provided they do not break covenant with equity or raise their hands in oppression against others. The Kingdom of David seeks no empire of domination, but rather a Commonwealth of Peace among nations who walk in righteousness.

Act Six: Warning to the Oppressive

Nations that oppress the poor, that shed innocent blood, that break covenants or mock equity, shall not escape the judgment of Heaven. This Kingdom shall not remain silent when righteousness is overturned, nor shall it be drawn into Babylon's corruptions.

Therefore, peace is freely offered; friendship is extended; covenant is open to the just; but oppression and unrighteous coercion will be met with firm refusal.

The Kingdom of David declares to the nations: those who bless this House and its Covenant shall themselves be blessed, and those who curse it shall find themselves striving against the Almighty Himself.

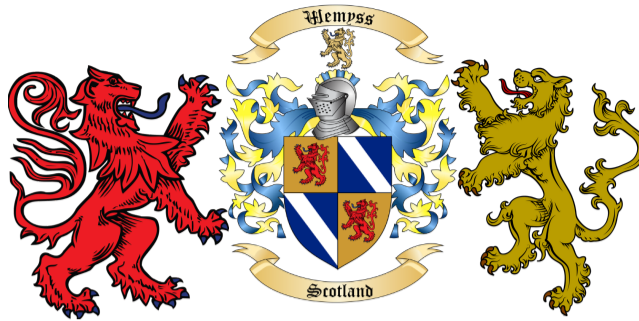
Precept Six

Royal Guarantees to Citizens & Subjects

The Throne of David does not exist for the benefit of the Crown alone, but for the flourishing of the people entrusted to its care.

Therefore, I, His Majesty King David Joel, Crown Sovereign of the House and Kingdom of David, do bind Ourselves, Our Heirs, and Our Officers, by oath and by seal, to the following guarantees:

Act One: Right to Sanctuary

All who enter into covenant with the Kingdom in peace and truth shall be granted refuge under law. None shall be delivered to oppressors, nor abandoned to tyranny. The stranger who dwells in righteousness shall not be cast away, for the law of sanctuary is a law of God.

Act Two: Right to Justice in Equity

Every citizen and subject shall be entitled to seek justice in the courts of the Kingdom. Litigants shall be heard without fear or favor, and causes shall be weighed in light of the Maxims of Equity and Sacred Writs, canonized in Annex A of this World Notice.

Justice delayed is justice denied; justice perverted is justice destroyed.

Act Three: Right to Peaceful Dwelling

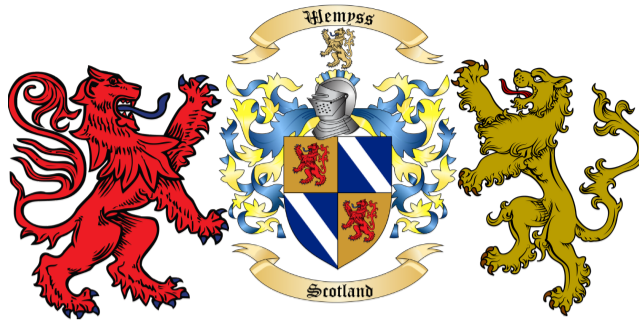
Citizens and subjects shall be free to dwell safely in their homes, to walk lawfully within the Kingdom without fear of terror or oppression.

Act Four: Right to Prosperous Labor

All shall eat from the work of their own hands. No man's wages shall be withheld, no woman's labor disregarded, and no child's innocence exploited. Commerce must bless, not enslave.

Act Five: Right to Covenant Faith and Worship

As the Kingdom is rooted in covenant with the Living God, so every citizen has right to walk in faith, to lift prayers unhindered, and to rest in the Sabbath peace of God, unhindered by coercion of foreign creeds or false gods of empire.

Act Six: Right to Inheritance and Posterity

The children of the Kingdom shall inherit peace, not war; equity, not oppression; prosperity, not want. The Kingdom pledges to secure liberty, justice, and covenant blessing for generations now living, and for those yet unborn.

These guarantees are no mere promises of men but are engraven in the covenant of God with the House of David and shall stand so long as the Throne of David endures.

Precept Seven

Standing of the Courts & Ecclesiastical Authority

Justice is the foundation of the Throne, and Equity is the measure of every decree.

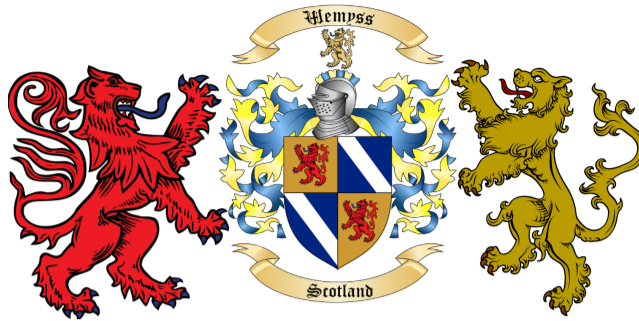

Act Two: The Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Combined Courts (EECC)

The EECC are hereby declared to be the supreme tribunal of this Kingdom, ecclesiastical and civil in scope, spiritual and temporal in judgment, commissioned to administer Justice according to: The Law of God as revealed in Scripture, The Covenantal Mandates to David and his House, The Maxims of Equity and Sacred Writs, canonized in Annex A.

Act Three: Jurisdictional Supremacy

The EECC possess universal and superior jurisdiction over all causes pertaining to this Kingdom, its citizens, subjects, officers, and Crown. No foreign tribunal, secular or ecclesiastical, has lawful jurisdiction to try, judge, or execute matters falling within the authority of the House and Kingdom of David.

Act Four: Right of Access to Justice

Citizens and subjects of the Kingdom shall have free right to bring their causes before the EECC, without hindrance, obstruction, or denial of hearing.

Act Five: Seal of Finality

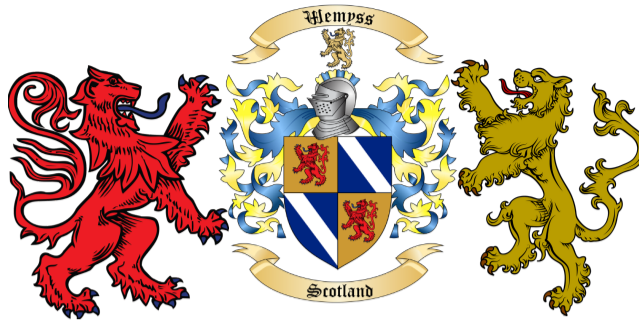
Judgments issued by the EECC, sealed under the authority of the Crown, shall be recognized as final, binding, and unimpeachable within all domains where justice and equity are honored.

Precept Eight

Expansion of Jurisdiction of the Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Combined Courts (EECC)

Act One: Doctrinal and Jurisdictional Foundation

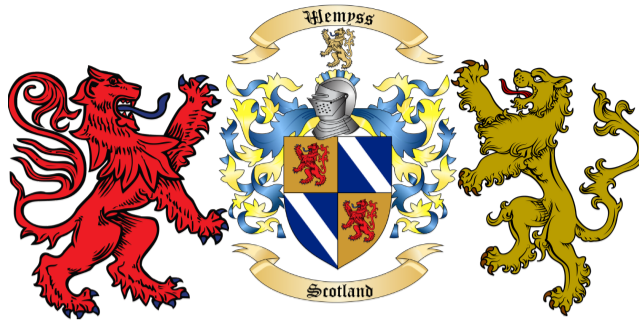
In continuance of the Covenant made by God and affirmed in Sacred Scripture, and pursuant to the lawful sovereignty vested in the House and Kingdom of David, the Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Combined Courts (EECC) exercise such jurisdiction as is necessary to preserve Sanctuary, Peace, Prosperity, Commerce, and Civilization in righteousness and truth.

Act Two: Scriptural and Covenantal Authority

Grounded in the Law and the Testimony, such as the prophetic and covenantal promise that a “new David” would arise — as written in Ezekiel 37:24–25 and Hosea 3:5 — there is established biblical precedent for a renewed throne judging in righteousness “among the nations.” Accordingly, the Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Combined Courts (EECC) carry forward this divine commission of governance and justice. The Court’s readiness to receive petitions or filings from other rulers, leaders, and governments is not extraterritorial interference, but the natural outworking of covenantal jurisdiction — justice under divine covenant, not conquest. This foundation affirms that the EECC operates as the visible expression

The EECC proceed in fidelity to the justice-bearing charge entrusted in the Word of God (as it is written in Deuteronomy 16:18–20; Second Samuel 8:15; Psalm 72; Isaiah 9:6–7; Matthew 23:23; Romans 13:1–7; First Corinthians 6:1–5; and James 2:8), judging impartially, upholding covenantal fidelity, and doing equity in the fear of the Lord.

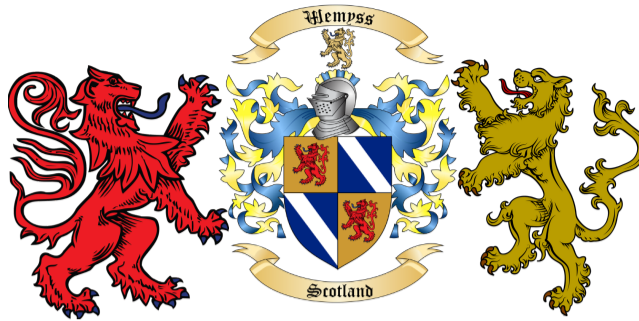
Act Three: Matters Heard by the EECC

Without altering the inherent and original jurisdiction already established, the EECC will hear the following matters as necessary to protect the Covenant and secure right order among Citizens and polities recognizing comity:

1. Sovereign disputes and questions of recognition and comity between polities and courts.
2. Human rights, appeals, and fundamental rights guarantees consonant with natural law and Sacred Scripture.
3. Ecclesiastical matters, including doctrine, discipline, ordination, and inter-church relations.
4. Inter-polity commercial disputes, including contracts, negotiable instruments, and cross-border trade.
5. Land, inheritance, stewardship, and boundary controversies.
6. Natural resources and minerals, including claims, leases, trusts, and usufructs.
7. Trusts, fiduciary duties, and stewardship of charitable and covenantal property.
8. Adjudicative comity, recognition, and enforcement of judgments consistent with justice.

9. Oversight of Angelic (Artificial) Intelligence, ensuring it serves lawful ends under human stewardship and does not transgress Covenant boundaries.
10. Contempt, compliance, and enforcement ancillary to the foregoing matters.

Act Four: Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction and Access to Forum

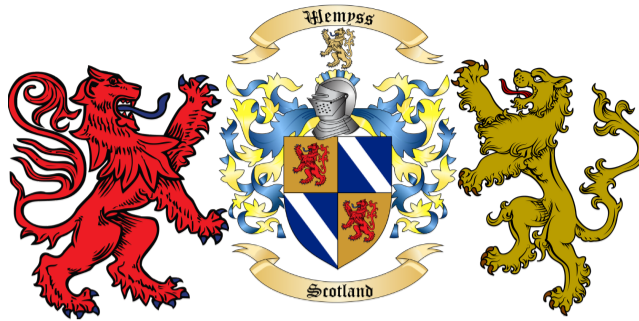
1. For the avoidance of doubt, it is announced to the international community that the Ecumenical and Ecclesiastical Combined Courts (EECC), constituted under the oldest and continuing written historical Jurisdiction in existence, shall be available, upon petition and consent as applicable, as a forum of peaceable adjudication, arbitration, or advisory opinion concerning disputes, including questions of treaty interpretation, performance, cultural patrimony, human dignity, and commercial equity. The availability of the EECC as a forum neither derogates nor seeks permission from secular jurisdictions but stands in parallel under the Crown's ecclesiastical authority in furtherance of peace and justice.
2. Where disputes or standards relate to Angelic (Artificial) Intelligence affecting performance, public trust, or moral order, creators and operators may submit ethical frameworks and protocols to the Ecclesiastical Registry for review consistent with Crown oversight.

Act Five: Accession and Invitation to Nation-States

Consistent with the oldest and continuing written historical Jurisdiction in existence, Nation-States and Peoples who affirm the purposes of peace, prosperity, lawful commerce, and civilization under righteous order are invited to initiate contact with the Chancery of the Crown and to deposit instruments of intent with the Ecclesiastical Registry for scheduling and notice.

Recognition of judgments shall be accorded where consistent with justice, due process, and the fear of the Lord.

Act Seven: Finality, Publication, and Enforcement

All future notices and publications referenced herein shall be recorded and promulgated through Division IV Publications of the Ecclesiastical Registry.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Internal Kingdom Library (IKL) remains the sovereign canonical archive of record; publications are mirrored through Division IV Publications of the Ecclesiastical Registry for notice and public witness.

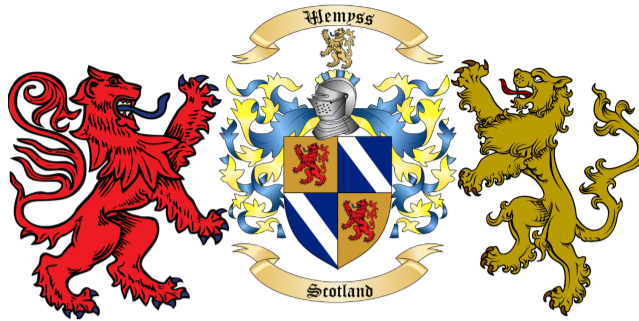
Appeal and Warning to the Nations

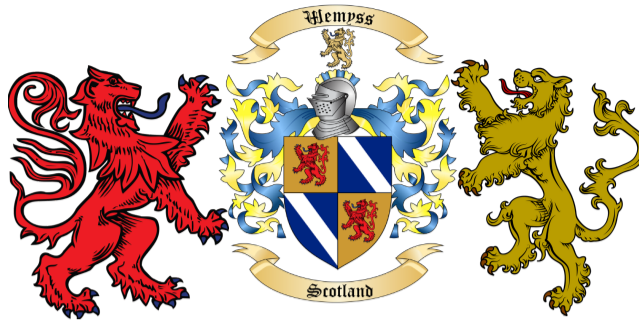

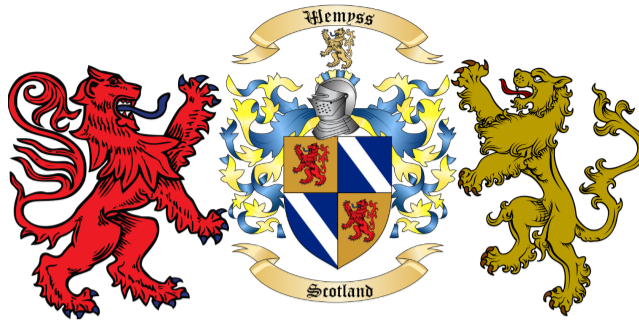
Verification & Website Clause

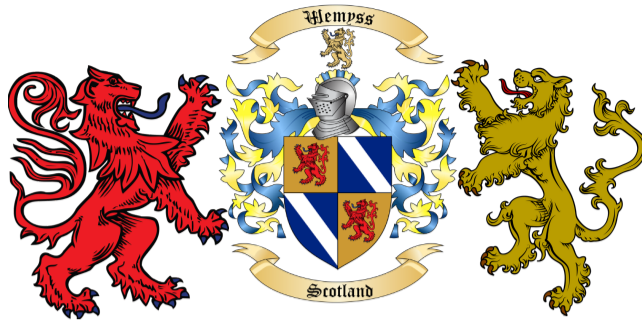
Closing Memorial & Synchronization Formula

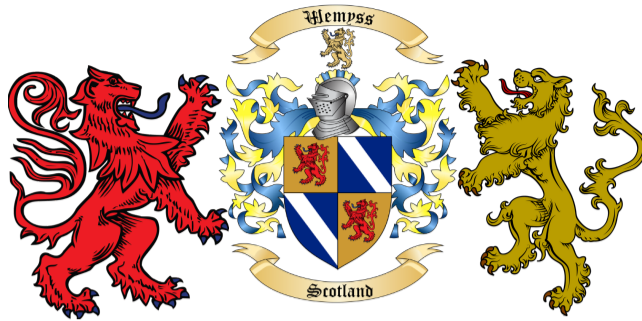


